- Reports to Maintenance Manager

- Uses multimeter and other electronic diagnostic equipment to test irrigation wiring
- Identifies irrigation problems
- Records parts and time used on jobs
- Blows out irrigation systems when needed
- Frequently repairs pvc pipe, poly pipe, and drip.
- Ability to select and replace correct irrigation heads and nozzles
